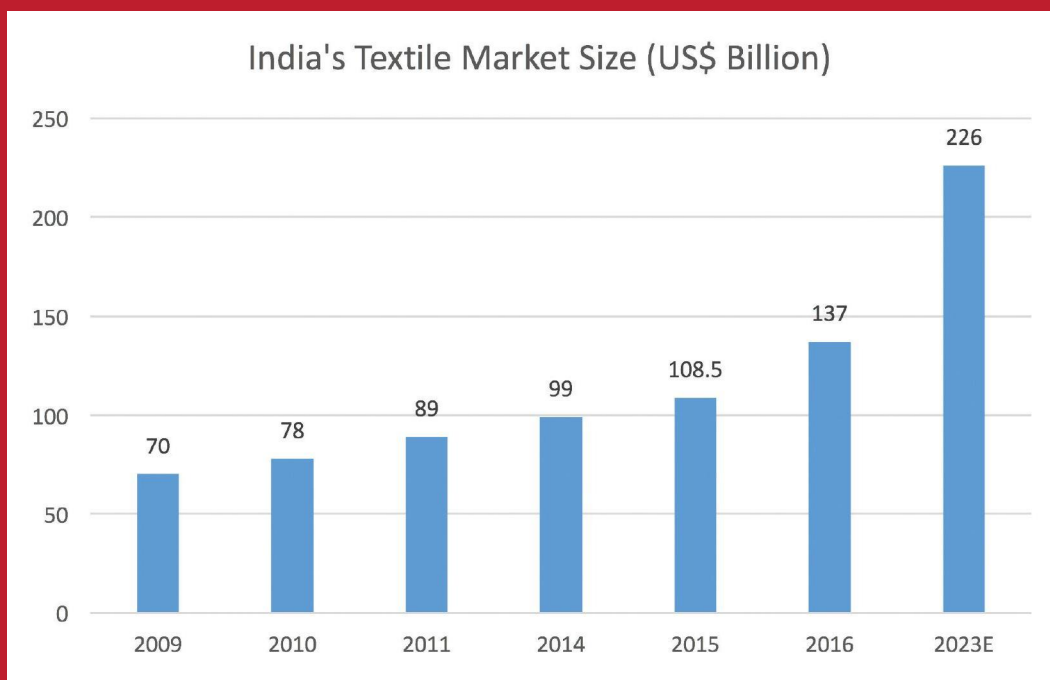




Maharashtra: Textile Sector

1. INDIA

- A. Indian textiles industry, currently estimated at around US\$ 120 billion, is expected to reach US\$ 230 billion by 2020.
- B. It contributes approximately 2 per cent to India's Gross Domestic Product (GDP), 10 per cent of manufacturing production and 14 per cent to overall Index of Industrial Production (IIP).
- C. Indian khadi products sales increased by 33 per cent year-on-year to Rs 2,005 crore (US\$ 311.31 million) in 2016-17 and is expected to exceed Rs 5,000 crore (US\$ 776.33 million) sales target for 2018-19, as per the Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC).
- D. The industry (including dyed and printed) attracted Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) worth US\$ 2.68 billion during April 2000 to September 2017.
- E. The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA), Government of India has approved a new skill development scheme named 'Scheme for Capacity Building in Textile Sector (SCBTS)' with an outlay of Rs 1,300 crore (US\$ 202.9 million) from 2017-18 to 2019-20.
- F. The Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) has revised rates for incentives under the Merchandise Exports from India Scheme (MEIS) for two subsectors of Textiles Industry - Readymade garments and Made ups - from 2% to 4%.

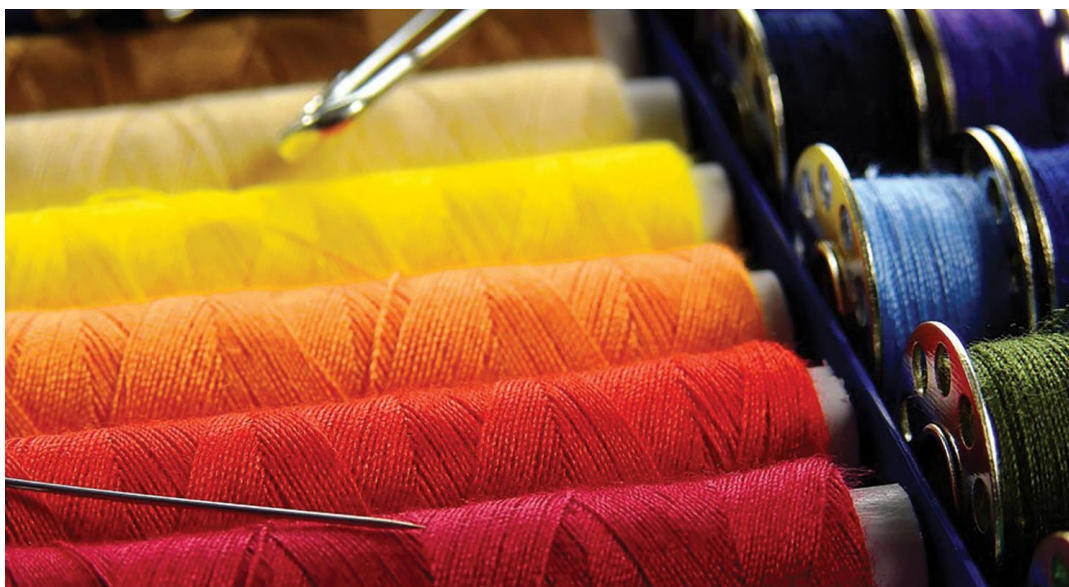
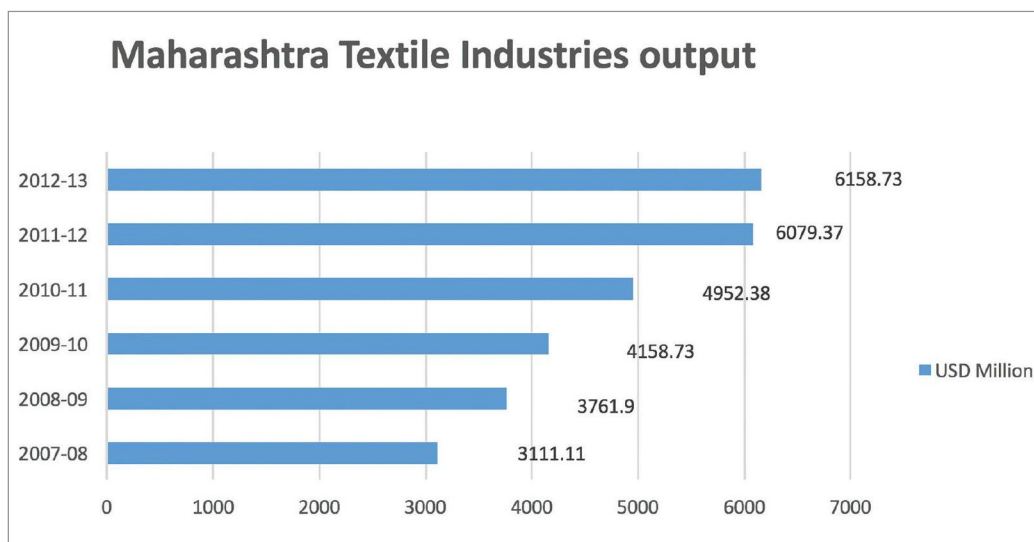

2. MAHARASHTRA

- A. From August 1991 to November 2016, 958 projects under the textile sector have been commissioned. These projects are worth Rs. 17,169 Crore.
- B. The Government is planning 9 textile parks in the state. The textile park at Amravati has over 30 units operational.
- C. Maharashtra is the largest cotton producer in India with largest area under cultivation for cotton, that is, 3,827 thousand hectares during 2015-16.
- D. The state produced 8.9 million bales of cotton in 2016-17.

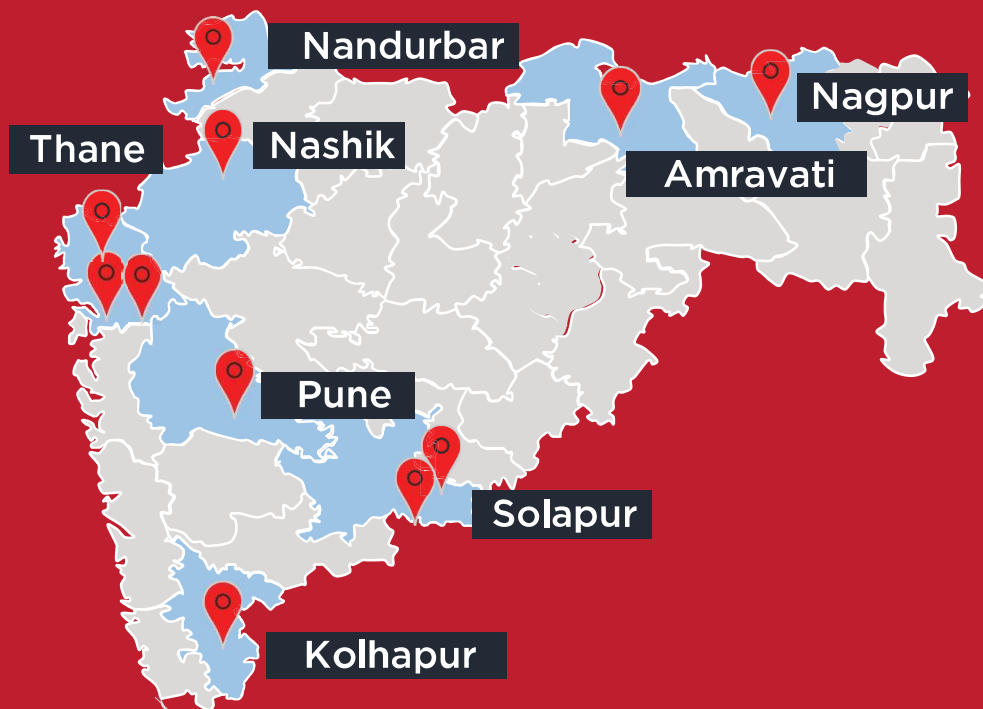

Existing infrastructure in Maharashtra



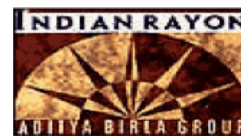
3. MAJOR TEXTILE HUBS

- A. MIDC has developed 11 exclusive textile parks, one in Amravati, three in Thane, two in Solapur, one each in Kolhapur, Nagpur, Nashik, Pune and Nandurbar with facilities such as R&D laboratory / Institute, Trade centre, Management and Training centre, Product / Process development laboratory
- B. More that 2,000 textile industries in the state with fixed capital of USD 2,417 millions.
- C. State has signed memorandums of understanding (MoU) of worth USD 2,960 million with major investments from textile sector.
- D. Amravati - Nandgaonpeth - 500 Ha of land has been taken in possession by MIDC to develop textile park, the textile unit is expected to provide 8000 jobs.
